



# ASHA's Faculty Development Institute (AFDI)

## Description

ASHA's Faculty Development Institute aims to help communication sciences and disorders (CSD) faculty develop and implement educational enhancements that incorporate approaches consistent with the future of learning to prepare CSD graduate students for the future of work. The institute will consist of a virtual workshop for faculty spanning three days in addition to prerecorded presentations viewed asynchronously that focus on how to teach and incorporate the four AFDI topic areas into CSD education.

### AFDI Topic Areas

- Cultural Competence
- Enhanced Service Delivery/Top of the License
- Evidence-based Practice
- Interprofessional Education and Collaborative Practice

## Learning Outcomes

Participants of AFDI will be able to:

1. Describe strategies to align education with evolving practice and the future of work, specifically relative to cultural competence, enhanced service delivery/top of the license, evidence-based practice, and interprofessional practice.
2. Identify up to three focus areas for making educational enhancements and effecting change in CSD academic programs.

The seven focus areas listed below are areas in which educational enhancements were identified by AFDI participants in prior years. There may be other areas that have not yet been proposed and participants should feel encouraged to develop implementation plans in whatever area is deemed important to change.

- Clinical Education
- Didactic Coursework/Syllabus
- Curricular Design and Pedagogical Approaches
- Faculty Development and Education
- Developing Collaborations
- Building a Coalition/Changing Culture
- Scholarship of Teaching and Learning
