# Share your story with Others!

- Tell others about your story.

# Improve your reading skills!

## GUESS

Look at the cover, pictures, and title of the book. While reading, predict what will happen and why.

## QUESTION

Ask yourself questions about important ideas in the story such as what the characters might do or what you might learn.

## UNDERSTAND

Do you understand what you are reading? Does it make sense? If not, reread, look at illustrations, or read ahead.

## EXAMINE

Think about the characters, setting, and problems the characters face. Think about the important ideas in the story.

## DECODE

If you don't understand a word, look at the letters, sounds, and word parts you know. Blend sounds to pronounce the word. Look in the dictionary for the meaning of the word.

## REVIEW

Ask yourself questions like: Did you like the story? What was the story about? To understand better, read it again!
