## **2010** *Student Ethics Essay Award*

ASHA is pleased to announce the opening of the fifth annual Student Ethics Essay Award (SEEA) competition.

### **2010 Essay Topic**

“Within the context of the ASHA Code of Ethics, how has the emergence of technology impacted the issues of confidentiality, privacy, and security of individuals’ records and protected health information?”

### **Award Eligibility**

Eligible candidates include NSSLHA members enrolled part time or full time during the academic year 2009-2010 in an undergraduate or graduate-level CSD program. Graduate students must be enrolled in a program currently accredited (or in Candidacy status) by the Council on Academic Accreditation in Audiology and Speech-Language Pathology.

Students will submit essays to their NSSLHA Chapter Advisor for initial review by April 16, 2010. Each NSSLHA chapter may select **up to five** student essays for submission to ASHA by April 23, 2010 for the final review and selection process. (Note: NSSLHA members who are not affiliated with a specific NSSLHA chapter may submit their entries to their Regional Councilors.)
