## VERIFICATION OF POSTGRADUATE PROFESSIONAL CLINICAL EXPERIENCE

Individuals who have **less than one year** (1,260 hours) of postgraduate professional clinical experience must complete a Clinical Fellowship experience supervised by an individual holding either ASHA or CASLPA certification. A clinical fellowship experience is defined as the equivalent of 36 weeks of professional employment as a speech-language pathologist at 35 hours per week. During this clinical experience, these applicants will need to demonstrate successful achievement of the skills identified in the current Clinical Fellowship Skills Inventory (CFSI) instrument.

Applicants from CASLPA who have **at least one year** (1,260 hours) of postgraduate professional clinical experience completed within the 5 years immediately prior to applying for ASHA certification must complete the following information and submit it with their application for certification.
