Time Frame	Expected Releases	ASHA & Member Engagement
Summer 2026	MPFS Proposed Rule Release	ASHA will comment on the code set and values as appropriate through the official comment making process; ASHA will inform and engage members. AMA RUC/HCPAC Review Board will defend their recommendations via comments as needed.
Summer 2026	ASHA Education after the proposed rule release	ASHA will provide member education and preparation resources in a timely fashion as information is released. Resources will include webinars, printables, template letters, and question-answer sessions.
September 2026	AMA 2027 CPT Code Book Release	



September 14, 2026	CMS Official Comment Period for Proposed Rule Closes.	ASHA will provide comments to CMS on the proposed rule by September 14, 2026, deadline.
November 2026	MPFS Final Rule Release	
Fall-Winter 2026	Final Preparations	ASHA will release implementation resources and continue member education
January 1, 2027	New codes will be implemented	ASHA will continue member education. See slides for additional considerations.
