4	I ask for assistance or clarification when I am unsure how to implement a care plan.
5	I am prepared for my sessions.
6	I select appropriate materials for treatment sessions.
7	I accurately document session results within expected timelines.
8	I maintain appropriate confidentiality of records.
9	I adhere to my scope of practice for my role as an SLPA.
10	I speak up if I am asked to conduct tasks that fall outside my scope of practice.

12	I am comfortable reporting results.
13	I am comfortable making suggestions to my supervisor.
14	I understand my employer's policies and procedures (e.g., scheduling, workplace conduct).
