



Supervised Clinical Practicum Hours for ASHA's Certificate of Clinical Competence in Speech-Language Pathology (CCC-SLP)

Applicants for certification in speech-language pathology from the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association (ASHA) must have completed a minimum of 400 supervised clinical practicum hours during their graduate program. These activities must be within the [ASHA Scope of Practice for Speech-Language Pathology](#) and include all core competencies across the lifespan of clients/patients as outlined in the [2020 certification standards](#).

The program director/principal must indicate (a) the number of supervised hours in each direct clinical service area; (b) the specific location(s) where the applicant completed their clinical hours; (c) the name of clinical supervisor(s) and their appropriate credentials; and (d) the dates of completion. There is no minimum number of hours required in any clinical area. Time spent preparing for clinical care and completing documentation cannot be counted.

After inputting all information in the following charts, the program director/principal must sign the form. Signatures can be either manual/wet or digital with authentication. The program director/principal must email the completed form to ASHA at certification@asha.org from an official university email address, or print and mail it to: ASHA Certification Department, 2200 Research Boulevard #313, Rockville, MD 20850.
