

Listening Games

Script/Explanation

You can use or modify the following script to introduce listening games:

Listening helps us learn, play, and understand each other. We are going to play a fun game that shows us why listening is so important. Pay close attention to see how listening makes the game work!

- **Telephone**
 - Sit in a circle.
 - The first person whispers a sentence to the next person.
 - Each person whispers what they hear to the next person.
 - The last person says the sentence out loud.
 - Notice how the message changes if we don't listen carefully.

- **Red Light, Green Light**
 - One person is the "traffic light" and stands in front.
 - When the traffic light says "Green light," everyone moves forward.
 - When the traffic light says "Red light," everyone freezes.
 - If you move on a red light, you are out.
 - The first person to reach the traffic light wins!
 - This game teaches us to listen carefully so we know when to stop and when to go.

- **Simon Says**
 - One person is "Simon."
 - Simon gives commands like "Simon says touch your toes."
 - Follow the command ONLY if the person giving the command says, "Simon Says."
 - If you follow a command that did not start with the words "Simon Says," you are out of the game.
 - The last person to stay in the game wins!
 - This game shows that listening helps us follow the correct instructions.
