No grant-writing experience required

Purpose

Assists clinical researchers in designing a 5-year career plan, building a publication record, and identifying early-career funding mechanisms to successfully launch independent research careers.

Am I Eligible?

- ✓ I have completed, or am at the dissertation-stage of, a PhD program.*
- ✓ I am an early-career scientist.
- ✓ My research addresses clinically-relevant questions.

Lessons for Success

(funded in part by NIDCD)

Extramural research grant-writing experience required

Purpose

Provides intensive training to promising early-career scientists in the grantsmanship skills and professional competencies needed to advance research careers.

Am I Eligible?

- ✓ I have completed, or am at the dissertation-stage of a PhD program.*
- ✓ I am an early-career scientist.
- ✓ I have either a) been awarded extramural research funding, or b) applied for federal research funding.

Clinical Practice Research Institute

Federal research grant-writing experience required

Purpose

Helps scientists compete successfully for federal funding to support clinical practice research: research in epidemiology, prevention, assessment, intervention, outcomes measurement, implementation science, knowledge translation, or multi-site clinical trials.

Am I Eligible?

- ✓ I have completed a PhD.
- ✓ I want to advance or shift my research to focus on clinical practice research.
- ✓ I have received research funding.
- ✓ I have applied for *federal* research funding.
- ✓ I am eligible to apply for U.S. federal research funds.
