VERIFICATION OF POSTGRADUATE PROFESSIONAL CLINICAL EXPERIENCE

Individuals who have **less than one year** (1,260 hours) of postgraduate professional clinical experience must complete a Clinical Fellowship experience supervised by an individual holding either ASHA or SAC certification. A clinical fellowship experience is defined as the equivalent of 36 weeks of professional employment as a speech-language pathologist at 35 hours per week. During this clinical experience, these applicants will need to demonstrate successful achievement of the skills identified in the current Clinical Fellowship Skills Inventory (CFSI) instrument.

Applicants from SAC who have **at least one year** (1,260 hours) of postgraduate professional clinical experience completed under the supervision of an individual holding either ASHA or SAC certification must complete the following information and submit it with their application for certification. Please include a verification letter showing your supervisor's certification during your clinical experience.
